

How to Apply for our Scholarship Programs

Higher Education Scholarships (HE)

For traditional college programs, such as Associate, Bachelors, and master's degrees at university.

1. Go to mybbnc.net
2. Log in to your account. If you do not have an account, register for one by clicking the "REGISTER" button and follow the instructions.
3. Click the **BENEFITS** drop down menu and select **Bristol Bay Foundation**.
4. Select the Higher Education Program **Application Portal** button.
5. Click on "Programs" to select Higher Education Scholarship.
6. Apply by the first Friday in April for full academic year funding. (HIGHLY Recommended)
7. Apply by the first Friday in December for spring funding, which covers **only** one term. You'll need to reapply for the next full academic year.

Career Focused Vocational Education (CFVE)

For non-university training programs through technical schools and training, such as welding, piloting, beauty school, electrical, cosmetology etc. 6 months or longer but less than 2 years.

1. Go to mybbnc.net
2. Log in to your account. If you do not have an account, register for one by clicking the "REGISTER" button and follow the instructions.
3. Click the **BENEFITS** dropdown menu and select **Bristol Bay Foundation**.
4. Select the "Career Focused Vocational Education Scholarship" Program **Application Portal** button.
5. CFVE has three deadlines a year which are typically in April, July and December, follow us on social media for exact dates and announcements

Ikayurnga Emergency Aid

BBF offers an emergency aid program for currently enrolled scholarship recipients, available once per academic year. This program helps students address urgent needs that could impact their ability to continue their studies. Open year-round, the aid can cover unexpected expenses such as housing costs, food, utilities, medical and dental care, childcare, transportation issues, and internet connectivity.

1. Sign in to your myBBNC account at myBBNC.net (do not enter "www"). *If you do not have an account, register for one by clicking the "REGISTER" button and follow the instructions.*
2. Click the **BENEFITS** drop down menu and select **Bristol Bay Foundation**.
3. Select either the Higher Education or Career Focused Vocational Education Scholarship Program Application Portal buttons
4. Top Right you select **PROGRAMS**
5. Click Start Application for the Ikayurnga Emergency Aid Program
